Friendly Reminders:

<u>Park</u> your cars in your garage first, then the driveway. If cars are parked on the street, they must be parked in the direction of traffic flow. This is true for Cul de Sac parking as well.

<u>Painting!</u> If your home is 8+ years old, it is probably time to consider repainting. We've noticed that non-stucco surfaces need painting sooner than the rest of the home. Look at your trim, shingle accents and doors, they will fade more quickly as well.

Remember, to keep your eyes open! It's the time of year for rattlesnakes, coyotes and wildfires. As the weather heats up, so do the risks. Take proactive steps to avoid dangerous encounters when you are out and about.
