LCO amenities will remain open for our members to use, below is some helpful information from the CDC.

According to the most recent information from the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) and government agencies, the risk of being exposed to the virus is thought to be low. We will continue to monitor the situation with state and local health departments and the CDC.

According to CDC, the Coronavirus has three main symptoms, fever, cough and shortness of breath. Please seek medical advice from a medical provider if you develop these symptoms, or you have been in contact with someone known to have the virus, or have recently been to an area in the US or International Country listed as high risk by the CDC.

Effective immediately, if you have visited a country listed as "elevated high risk" on the CDC website, you will be required to see a medical provider upon your return to the US and provide documentation to confirm you do not have the virus. In addition, you will be required to "self-quarantine" at home for 14 days prior to returning to the office. The current countries listed as High Risk Level 3 are: China, Italy, Iran, South Korea and Level 2 are: Japan. Please be aware this list may change from day to day and more countries may be added.

According to CDC the best to protect yourself:

- practice frequent handwashing for at least 20 seconds
- cover your mouth after coughing and sneezing with a tissue and immediately throw the tissue away
- avoid touching your eyes, nose, or mouth with unwashed hands
- stay home if you are sick
- avoid contact with people who are sick
- clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces, such as keyboards, work surfaces, cell phones, and keys avoid handshakes and hugging
